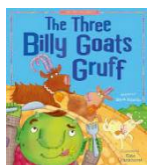

I	go	to	the	into
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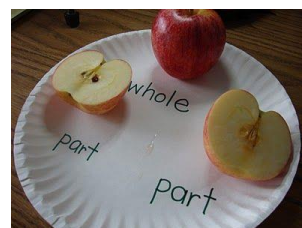
WORDS OF THE WEEK: This week's words have been linked to the troll. Maybe your child can read the words and then put them in a sentence.
