THIS WEEK YEAR R HAVE BEEN LEARNING.....

PHONICS: We are continuing to revise sounds the children have already learnt. Our focus this half term is to sound and blend words. Can your child sound and blend the following words:

TIME TO SHINE: In time to shine this week the children have been looking for signs of winter and exploring ice. To start the week went for a winter walk, this is something you can talk to you child about on their journey to school each day. We ended the week by exploring water and how we can change it into ice by freezing it. The children really enjoyed finding out how they could melt the ice.



MATHS: In maths this week we have been learning to identify groups of objects and then matching to the corresponding number. The children have also started to subitise to 6 using the patterns of a dice. Playing games at home will support this.

MONKEY TIME: Each day the children will be taking part in Monkey Time. This is where children are developing letter formation. We start by doing lots of exercises and movements to build strength in their bodies, see what happens when you ask your child to pose like a penguin, a meerkat, a stone lion, a gorilla or a lizard.
