


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Year R Weekly Information Sheet 13/5/2022

WEATHER: We have been experiencing some lovely sunny weather recently but this can be mixed. Please can you ensure your child is bringing a coat to school so we can still enjoy the weather outside. When the weather is sunny children are welcome to bring a named sun hat and ensure they have a water bottle.

THIS WEEK YEAR R HAVE BEEN LEARNING.....

PHONICS: This week we have introduced the diagraphs igh as in night and ee as in sheep. We are now going back over the diagraphs the children have already learnt to build up their confidence in the sounds. Children today have brought home their booklets they have been working on all week so please spend time practicing the sounds they are learning at home.



STORY TIME: This week we have been reading the story of Room on a Broom. We have identified some interesting words from the story which we call Ninja Words. Children have been using these words when acting out the story and through their play. The animation of the story can be found on iPlayer.



MATHS: This week the children have been learning their number bonds to 5. They have been getting 5 objects and finding ways they can make it - such as 5 is made of 3 and 2, 5 is made of 4 and 1 etc. We have also started to look at finding the missing number, so if I have 4 and I need 5 how many are missing?

KINETIC LETTERS: This week the children have been learning to write the Curved Lined capital letters **D P B R J U**. The children then had a go at writing sentences starting with he, she, they and we. We have attached the sheets to go with these capital letters so children can practice at home.

ROUND THE WORLD: Today we have been learning about Spain. The children have located the country on the map, played the castanets, cut and stick Picasso faces and practiced the Flamenco dancing. The children have been really excited to find out about the different countries and where they are located on a map.
