**THIS WEEK YEAR R HAVE BEEN LEARNING.....**

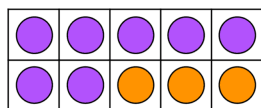
**PHONICS:** This week we have introduced the digraphs **oa as in goat, oo.... as in moon and oo.. as in book.** Children do find it tricky to identify the different oo sounds but by practicing the words in their phonics book it will help them to hear the difference in sounds.



**STORY TIME:** This week we have been reading the story of Stickman. We have identified some interesting words from the story which we call Ninja Words, these are not words the children need to read they are to increase children's vocabulary.

Children have been using these words when acting out the story and through their play. The animation of the story can be found on iPlayer. They have also been writing about what Stickman is used for in Monkey Time. The children have all been working so hard on their writing!
