DIVERSITY WEEK: It was lovely to see so many children dressed in bright clothing on Monday. Thank you also for your kind donations.

PHONICS: Please check your child's book bag for their phonics book. Children are having more focussed sessions so are all learning different sounds.



STORY TIME: This week we have been reading the story of Sharing Shell by Julia Donaldson. The children have been exploring the importance of sharing and compromise.

MATHS: The children this week have been learning to count up to 20 objects. We have been working on accurate counting and what to do when you can't move the object you are counting. The children have learnt to cross objects out or count in rows when counting things they can't move.

RE: This week we have been really lucky to have a visit from Southampton City Mission. They volunteer to come to schools and help teach children an aspect of the Christian Religion. This half term we have been focussing on Jesus as a story teller. At the beginning of the week we told our own stories and became story tellers. During our Question of Faith Day today we have recalled our favourite story and then learnt about stories that Jesus told.
