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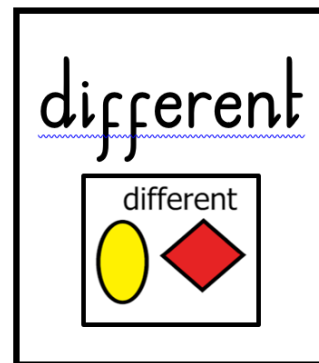
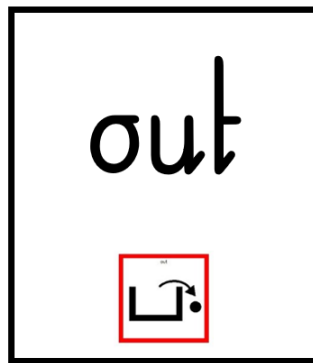
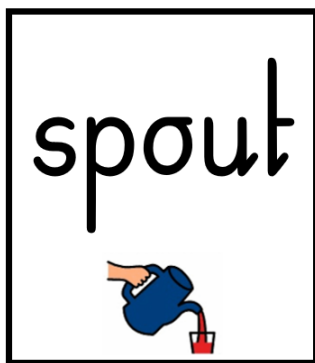

## THIS WEEK WE HAVE LEARNT

**NURSERY RHYMES:** This half term the children will be focusing on different nursery rhymes and other rhymes. This week our focus rhyme was Incy Wincy Spider.



**WORD AWARE:** This week we have Word Aware. This is where we introduce children to words and explain their meaning. Each week they will have 2 words which are topic words or found in a story or rhyme that we are learning about and the word is a 'concept word'. Concept words are words that shape how we think about the world. During the week children are exposed to these words and their meanings in lots of different ways and we hope you can support us at home by continuing to encourage the use of these.



**PHONICS:** This week the children have been learning the letter sounds **s**, **a**, **t**, **p**. Attached are sheets for the children to practice the sounds at home. If you need any support with the pronunciation of the sounds please visit Sign With Steve as he shows the cued articulation action and the letter sound. **MATHS:** In maths the children have been learning about matching objects, arranging objects into sets and sorting objects by type, this could be by size, colour or shape. Children at home could help by matching socks, getting sets of cutlery ready for meal times (knife, fork and spoon) and sorting toys such as lego.

## INFORMATION FOR GROWNUPS
