THIS WEEK WE HAVE LEARNT

NURSERY RHYMES: This week's nursery rhyme has been Hickory Dickory Dock.

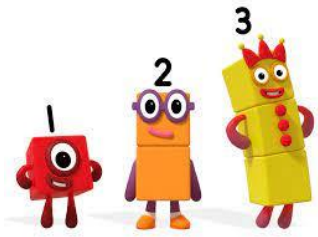
ZONES OF REGULATION: This week the children have been exploring the Green Zone. They have been identifying different behaviours which can be seen in the green zone. We often use the green zone during our carpet times to encourage the children to show they are in the green zone ready to learn. Here are the zones to recaap the different zones.

PHONICS: This week the children have been learning the letter sounds **u, r, h, b**. Attached are sheets for the children to practice the sounds at home. MATHS: In maths the children have been learning about whole and parts of objects. We have been looking at our own body parts and how we are still the whole. Children have then looked at the composition of the numbers 2 and 3. Number 2 is made of 1 and another 1. Number 3 is made of 2 and 1 or 1 and 1 and 1.

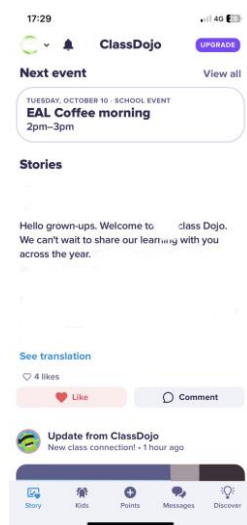

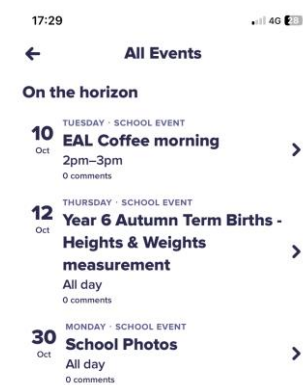
